Natuurlijk is het hun goed recht om dit bedrag te rekenen want we staan fijn binnen en niet in de regen en de kou zoals vaak bij andere markten. Helaas is het voor ons toch niet meer te doen onder het mom van 'We doen het voor ons plezier!' De rede van de Dutch Market was om meer jonge mensen geïnteresseerd te krijgen in de Club en dat is gelukt. Iedereen heeft het naar zijn zin, de in- en opzet is helemaal gelukt. Maar als ik, persoonlijk, al de onkosten eraf trek, mijn zaterdagavond om alles voor te bereiden, zondag ochtend om 7 uur beginnen om alles op tijd op de markt te krijgen. Om 2 - 2.30 uur weer thuis te zijn. Mijn zondag werk af zeggen maar daar dan ook nog voor te moeten betalen dan draai ik in de min en dat is dan een beetje zuur. Helaas zijn er van die momenten in het leven dat je moet kiezen en ik kies er dus voor om te stoppen met de verkoop van de poffertjes.

Ik dank iedereen voor de geweldige inzet en de gezelligheid. Vooral Demmy die het onzettend goed heeft opgepakt en daarmee een zeer goede werk-ervaring heeft gekregen. Dank aan Ron voor zijn hulp en het op en neer rijden en vooral het dragen van al de spullen. Soms moesten we met twee auto's rijden omdat hij na afloop van de markt door moest naar zijn werk.

En natuurlijk dank aan onze trouwe klanten die konden genieten van deze Nederlandse lekkernij. Ik wens iedereen het allerbeste en een goede gezondheid in het nieuwe jaar. Ik hoop iedereen weer snel te zien op de markt maar....dan als klant!
