Oma's Stamppot

Stamppot is considered age old, traditionally Dutch Cuisine, known as Boerenkool, Zuurkool, Andijvie and my favourite comfort food, time-travelling happy Hutspot served with a pool of gravy and meatballs/rookworst/baconbits Stamppot is traditionally made with white potatoes and above mentioned vegetables boiled for 20 min. and mashed up with butter, so easy. Hutspot is made of onions and carrots with potatoes.

With the change in seasons and dietery requirements per person there is every reason to explore stamppot with all the different vegetables available to us from the local farmers markets or your own garden. Look at my haul from yesterdays market, purple, orange and green and white veggies swap out with purple potatoes or pumpkin or kumara, onions for leeks and kale for sprouts or yams and kohlrabi or fennel bulb





Under \$ 5.00 per person

Procedure:

Wash, peel and cut vegetables of choice, put in pan and cover in water with pinch of salt, boil hard vege for 20 minutes. Drain (save 500 ML of drained cook water for gravy) pour rest over leafy greens, drain these and mix and mash (don't overmash) all together with knob of butter and serve hot with gravy/meat

Ingredients:

500 grams potatoes or pumpkin 500 grams other vegetables salt and pepper to taste

Notes :

Leftovers, freeze or or have later, pan fry, serve on toast or in oven dish as a cottage pie topped with cheese/breadcrumbs melted till goldenbrown.

Plantbased version, replace the butter, gravy and meat.

Adrie & Annie's story - part 4

I got approached by the Oosterhoutse nachtegalen, a youth choir from the Netherlands, in 2011. They wanted to come to New Zealand, travel around and perform at different places. We met up with the committee of the choir in Den Bosch while we were in the Netherlands that year and finalised plans with them. They came in 2012 with 30 children and 8 adults for whom I had to find host families, and in the end I was left with 13 people who stayed at our place.







The choir loved it here and travelled down south to Alexandra, where a past member lives. They performed in Mount Lyford, visited Kaikoura and wnet on the boat to watch the dolphins which was sponsored by John Jones Steel and Van Opzeeland transport. We organised a BBQ at the Netherlands society clubrooms where they gave a lovely performance as well as in a lot of different places in the south island and the choir decided to come back which they did in 2019. Once again we found host families, a few for the second time, for the choir members to stay with and this time we had 11 people staying with us. Quite a few host families still have contact with the choir. For us, we became friends for a lifetime and every year when we visit the Netherlands we meet up and get treated like royalty by the choir.

On Saturday the 16th of October 2021 I had the biggest surprise in my life. On that weekend the drama club Toenail Culture Ale had their yearly play and celebrated their 20th anniversary. At the end of the play I got called onto stage by the Ambassador, Mira Woldberg and was appointed to a member in the Order of Oranje Nassau. After that they told me to sit down and watch the screen. An other big surprise for me, the Oosterhoutse nachtegalen created a video clip and a beautiful song especially for me.

A night to always remember.

This will be our story for a while, we are going on holiday with the whole family to the Netherlands and will be back in September.

We counted at least 40 people, compared to Aucklands' 15 people who came to their AGM.




