Oma's HACHEE

Hachee comes from the French word, hacher, chopped or minced meat, its can be made with meat, fish or poultry but I know it only with beef. My oma used to make it with draadjes vlees, stewed with an acid, like wine or vinegar

Prep Time : 15 minutes Cook Time : 3 to 4 hours Servings : 4

Ingredients:

500 gram stewing meat
500 gram onions
1/2 cup flour, pinch salt/pepper
2 cups of water, half cup of winevinegar, tsp cloves, 3 bay leaves



Procedure:

- dice the meat in squares and stir in with flour mix
- 2. caramalise the onions
- 3. add the meat and turn down the heat when browned on the outside, add the liquid and spices and simmer for about 3 hours until soft

How many times have we heard this phrase?

When we were young and even more when we became old and had to say goodbye forever to the love of our life.

When we age we usually don't fall in love again, mostly because we are satisfied with the memories, which will last us for the rest of our lives.

However sometimes without looking for it something wonderful happens.

We might be in a crowded room and look at all the people around us and suddenly there is someone who catches our eye. We share a smile, we have a conversation and the world starts to turn in a way which we did not expect to ever happen again.

This happened to a person I know very well. She had been a widow for over 10 years and although many men had tried to get her interest, nobody had a chance because Tinie always sang the same song: "I'll never fall in love again!"

She was leading a busy life totally immersed in her family of children; grandchildren, great grandchildren and even a generation beyond that. She was a member of a walking group; a coffee morning gathering and a fitness club.

A typical Dutch housewife: Always busy in the house; tending her extensive garden; knitting and cooking dinners for family and friends.

She is well in her eighties but looks and acts like a well preserved sixty year old!

Often when I asked her if she was lonely or still missed her husband very much, she would answer: "No not really, I have all the lovely memories and when I want to talk with him I go to his graveside and tend the little plot of earth there and tell him what is bothering me or what is making me happy!"

So our Tinie was in the right frame of mind most of the time.

Then late last year at the Netherlands Society Christchurch Sunday Market she met up with a blast from the past. A man she met when she and her family first arrived in Christchurch as new immigrants. They had been neighbours and her children played with his children. But they had lost contact when they moved house and did not see each other ever again.

Until that Sunday late last year.

They immediately sat down together and talked for ages about days gone by. About the children and how they both had lost their partners. The sadness which had entered their lives and how they now coped with living alone.

When time approached for them to have to go home they realised that for a long time they had not had such a meaningful conversation and how they each understood exactly what the other was going through. They felt wonderfully happy even after they had said goodbye.

Days later they were still thinking about the meeting. Herman felt sorry he did not ask Tinie for her phone number. Because he would love to ask her out to go for a cup of coffee somewhere and have another chat. There was so much more he wanted to know about her life. He even approached a mutual friend to ask for her number however without luck. What to do?

I have been told Herman found Tinie's landline number in some old telephone book in the local library! We are now nearing Christmas 2022.

Tinie, very unusual, felt shy and insecure but still very keen to meet again with Herman. As a family and friends pre-Christmas gathering at her house was being planned she asked Herman to come and join and meet everyone.

I was present so I can tell you that it was such a special occasion! Everyone pretended not to know that Herman had come here especially to be with Tinie. A lot of whispering and giggling was going on. Everyone tried to have a chat with Herman to find out what kind of chap he was.

At a certain moment Tinie took Herman outside to show him the garden. (I presume...)

We, family and friends, quickly called for a vote of confidence and the result was a unanimous and heartfelt 'thumbs up' for Herman as a special friend for Tinie.

Tinie and Herman must have wondered what the enthusiastic cheer was for when they entered the room again.

Christmas came along and Herman invited Tinie to spend it with him and his family.

What happened in those couple of days I am not totally sure, only that the next time I spoke with Tinie she was all rosy and very happy: Yes it was a done deed, Tinie and Herman were in love!!!

It is so wonderful to see these two being so very happy. Wherever they are they hold hands, look deep into each other's eyes or are smiling at each other with so much admiration.

Whether it is dancing during the Dutch King's Birthday celebration or sitting next to each other watching television, that certain glow of true love surrounds them.

Oh yes, who was that again who said that in your late eighties you can't fall in love again? Now I hear them clearly singing: "Dan dans ik met jou door de hemelpoort heen, in de zevende hemel der liefde!"
